Illinois workNet Partners include existing Workforce Investment Act (WIA) mandated partners and many other organizations to include community-based and faith-based organizations, education entities, social service organizations, and libraries. Partners also include local agencies and organizations, such as local chambers of commerce and community college business development centers, that assist with or connect businesses to employee recruitment and training, and information and resources to help grow and manage a business. Partnerships are locally managed by Local Workforce Investment Boards.

Select from three partnership options:

Dissemination Partners – Display and provide information about and refer customers to the Illinois workNet website, use a partner decal, and have staff complete the Certified Illinois workNet Advisor Online Course.

Access Partners – Display and provide

information about Illinois workNet, provide access to the website via public access computers, use Illinois workNet “Web Access” decals, and have staff complete the Certified Illinois workNet Advisor Online Course.

Access/Service Provider Partners – Display and provide information about Illinois workNet, provide access to the website via public access computers, have staff available to assist customers, use Illinois workNet “Available Here” decals, and have staff complete the Certified Illinois workNet Advisor Online Course.
