



Continental Tire

Continental Tire is a German based multinational automotive parts manufacturing company, a leader in tire design and one of the words largest automotive manufacturers.

Continental Tire in Mt. Vernon, Illinois was looking for a way to develop an employment pipeline for their factory. Familiar with the German Dual Education System, they decided to take on an apprenticeship program. They have had an informal apprenticeship program since 2015 and their official registered apprenticeship program started in 2018. According to their navigator, they employ a lot of people in the area and are very community-oriented. They currently support a cohort of 14 apprentices but will have a new cohort of 12-16 apprentices every year for 3 years. Continental Tire's apprenticeship program is supported by the Industry Consortium for Advanced Technical Training (ICATT). Click the acronym for more information.

The navigator for this region states that the best parts of this program are that they truly understand the talent pipeline, they work phenomenally with recent high school graduates, they support a diverse group of apprentices, and they have a very low dropout rate.

Continental Tire states that the best part of having an apprenticeship program is that it is an investment in the community and the workforce. The apprenticeship program sets the company and its many employees up for success.

Continental Tire is currently building their own training area on site to offer related instruction to their apprentices. They have a designated trainer(s) that work directly with apprentices.

Continental Tire is a fantastic example of apprenticeship in Illinois!

Apprenticeship Education Tax Credit


Employers are allowed a tax credit for certain educational expenses associated with qualifying apprentices. Qualified educational expenses include tuition, book fees, and lab fees. The credit is up to \$3,500 per apprentice and an additional \$1,500 if (1) the apprentice resides in an underserved area or (2) the employer's principal place of business is located in an underserved area. The total tax credits may not exceed \$5 million annually.
