#### 1. APPRENTICESHIP APPROACH

#### 2. TERM OF APPRENTICESHIP

The term of this occupation shall encompass the successful attainment of approximately 2000 On-the-Job Learning (OJL) hours and sufficient demonstration of all (78) of the OJL competencies listed in the Work Process Schedule, plus successful completion of a minimum of 144 hours of supplementary AdventHealth Learning Network (ALN) coursework.

#### 3. RATIO OF APPRENTICES TO JOURNEYWORKERS

The Apprentice-to-Journeyworker Ratio is **01** Apprentice to **01** Journeyworker.

Adequate or proper supervision of the apprentice means the apprentice is under the supervision of a fully qualified journeyworker or supervisor at all times who is responsible for making work assignments, providing OJL, and ensuring safety at the worksite.

Proper supervision of an apprentice does not mean the apprentice must be within eyesight or reach of the supervisor, but that the supervisor knows what the apprentice is working on; is readily available to the apprentice; and is making sure the apprentice has the necessary instruction and guidance to perform tasks safely, correctly, and efficiently.

#### 4. APPRENTICE WAGE SCHEDULE

Under this Registered Apprenticeship, apprentices shall be paid a progressively increasing schedule of wages based on an established **Starting Wage** of **\$36.00** and a **Journeyworker Wage** (the wage an apprentice can expect to receive upon successful completion of their apprenticeship) of **\$36.72/hour**. These are minimum established hourly wages for this apprenticeship; if choosing to do so, an employer may always pay a higher wage.

#### 5. PROBATIONARY PERIOD

Every selected apprentice will serve a probationary period comprising the first 500 hours of this apprenticeship.

#### 6. SELECTION PROCEDURES

<u>UChicago Medicine AdventHealth Bolingbrook</u>, as the Registered Apprenticeship Program Sponsor, will adhere to established non-discriminatory and Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) policies and practices when recruiting and selecting apprentices, as well as administer the apprentice selection process in a fair and consistent manner.

- A. Every person requesting an application will have one made available.
- B. All applications will be identical in form and requirements.
- C. All applicants will be evaluated in the same manner, using identical, non-discriminatory criteria and processes.
- D. As part of the application process, all apprentice applicants may be required to provide supporting documents (driver's license; birth certificate or other acceptable proof of age, etc.).
- E. Completed applications will be checked for minimum qualifications. Applicants deficient in one or more qualifications or requirements or making false statements on their applications will be notified in writing of their disqualification and of the appeal rights available to them. No further processing of such applications will be taken.
- F. As applicable, applicants who meet the minimum qualifications established for the apprenticeship program and submit all required documents will be notified where and when to appear for an interview.



- G. The Program Sponsor will ensure the interview process is identical for all apprentice candidates.
- H. The Program Sponsor will ensure that applicants selected for the program review the applicable Registered Apprenticeship Program Standards, prior to the start of the apprenticeship.

- Active RN license in the State hired or in the state of Illinois, may practice as a License Pending Registered Professional Nurse under direct supervision for a period of three months from the official date of passing the licensure exam
