APPRENTICESHIP ILLINOIS COMMITTEE

The Apprenticeship Illinois Committee has four workgroups:

- 1. Marketing WG
- 2. Pre-Apprenticeship WG
- 3. Youth WG
- 4. The newly created Apprentice WG

The Apprentice Workgroup will:

- (1) Promote the value and benefits of apprenticeship across the state to employers, potential apprentices, elected officials, and more, and
- (2) Advise the Apprenticeship Illinois Committee from the apprentice perspective.





- Share their perspectives on Apprenticeship programs and their program experiences.
- Work closely with the leader of the IWIB Apprenticeship Committee's Apprentice Workgroup.
- Maintain professionalism, open communication, and transparency with their Apprenticeship employer with respect to their participation in this Initiative.
- Commit for a one-year term, with the term beginning January 2024 and ending December 2024.





- Attend a kickoff event, in-person, in January/February 2024 either in Springfield or Chicago.
- Attend up to three in-person meetings either in Chicago or Springfield. The kickoff event will be the first.
- Attend quarterly virtual meetings with the IWIB Apprenticeship Committee.
- Attend up to three virtual meetings for professional development.
- Complete at least one outreach activity in their region.





Apprentice Ambassadors will be chosen based on an application process.

- Both the apprentice and employer must complete forms.
 - The employer commitment form is <u>here</u>.
 - The apprentice application is here.
- Applications are due October 20, 2023.
- Selected apprentices notified the week of November 6, 2023.
- Apprentices and Employers announced publicly at a live in-person event on the first day of National Apprenticeship Week (Nov 13th).
