Opening an Illinois ABLE account empowers qualifying individuals with disabilities to save and invest for the additional expenses that come with having a disability without losing, or losing access to federal means-tested benefits. Illinois ABLE accounts foster person-centered independence, build self-reliance, encourage employment and improve quality of life. Contributions to ABLE accounts can come from earnings, family, friends and other sources. Earnings on ABLE accounts are tax-deferred, and withdrawals are tax-free as long as they are used for qualified disability-related expenses.
