## Illinois workNet Service Finder: Generating a Site-Specific URL

A Unique URL can be generated for any Partner Site entered into the <u>Illinois workNet Service Finder</u> and set as the homepage for that location's computer labs to track the usage of Illinois workNet. Instructions for creating or updating an Illinois workNet Service Finder Partner Site can be found under *Resources* on the <u>Service Finder Tool article</u>.

After the Unique URL is set up, users can use the *Unique URL Frequency Report* to track counts for users who are using Illinois workNet on their resource room computers. The designated Primary and Secondary Contacts of a Partner Site can view the usage statistics of their location. LWIA Coordinators and Managers can view the usage statistics within their LWIA, and DCEO and State Level staff can view the usage statistics for all locations added to the Service Finder.

**NOTE:** Users must have a Partner Level account to access the Unique URL Generator and Report. If you need Partner Level access, request to <u>Become A Partner</u> by sending an email to <u>info@illinoisworknet.com</u>. Include the following information:

<u>Reason for the email</u>: I would like to request an Illinois workNet partner account. Your name as it appears in your Illinois workNet account. Name of your organization as it appears in the Illinois workNet Service Finder. Organization address and work phone number.

- 1. Go to the Illinois workNet homepage: <u>https://www.illinoisworknet.com/</u>
- 2. Click **Login** in the header to sign into your existing workNet.
- 3. Once logged in, click on **My Dashboard** on the workNet banner and select **Service Finder Administration** under the Partner Tools section.
