1. Create / access your profile on LinkedIn.
2. Search for Illinois Virtual Job Club Network.
3. Request to join.

1. Review the current items in the discussion tab.
2. Start a discussion about an industry topic to see who answers the question. He or she could be a potential recruit.
3. Review the Promotion items in the Promotions tab. Post items to the promotions, such as job fairs or hiring events at your business.
4. Review the Jobs tab. If you have listed a job on LinkedIn, you may want to include it in this group or other groups. If it is posted on your website, share a link to the opening.
5. Review the Members tab. You could find a new connection or employee!

ACTION

Share action items from your company page on LinkedIn in the industry-related groups to which you belong.

Engage in discussions in the group. In some cases, this could provide a mentoring situation.
