This export guide provides step-by-step instructions for downloading your existing results from Skills & Interests Surveys. The final day to download your results from Illinois workNet is **June 8, 2026**.

While the CIS360 Skills and Interests Surveys will still be available through the Illinois Career Information System (CIS), provided by the Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES), they will no longer be connected to your Illinois workNet account once the new Interest Profiler is launched on June 9, 2026.

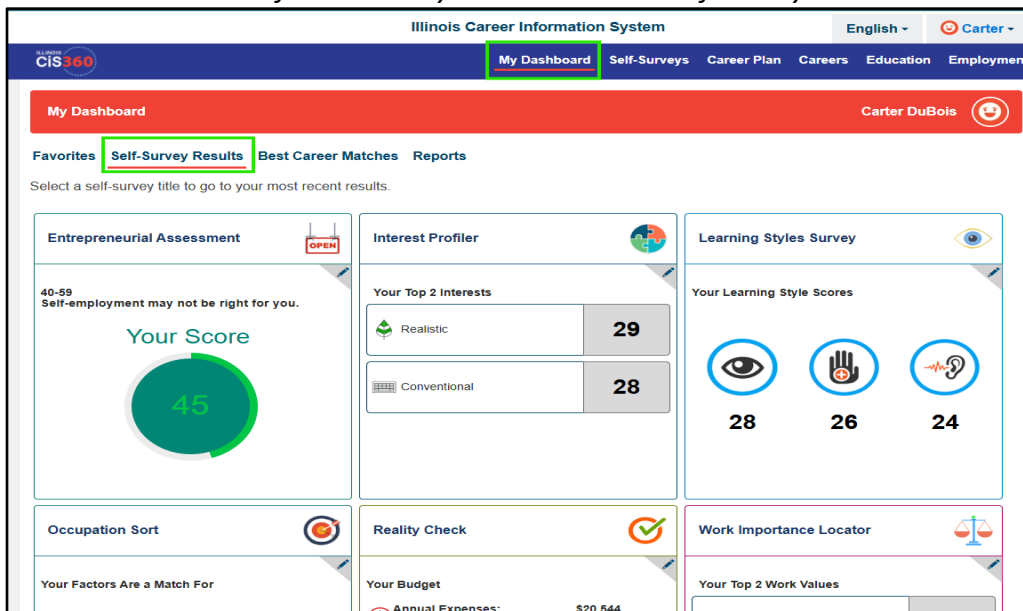
## Instructions:

1. Log in to your [Illinois workNet](#) account.
2. Once logged in, Click **Skills & Interests** located in the Header (orange ribbon) to access Illinois CIS360. *See the screenshot below for where Skills & Interests is located on Illinois workNet:*



3. On the Illinois CIS360 page, click **My Dashboard**.
4. Click **Self-Survey Results**.

5. Select a survey title.
6. Click the orange **Export PDF** button on the top right corner.
