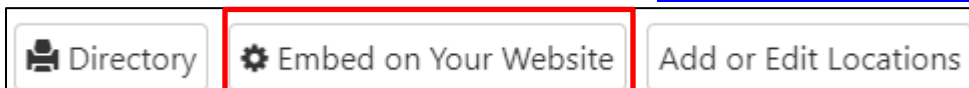


[Illinois workNet Service Finder](#) is a search tool to aid in finding locations across the state that provide in-person assistance and referrals. Illinois workNet Partner locations help access resources for job search, career preparation, and/or referrals for work support such as financial aid, childcare, and more. Locations include Illinois workNet Centers/American Job Centers, community based organizations, state agencies, libraries, education providers, etc. The Service Finder is maintained by Illinois workNet staff and updated by location specific contacts and Local Workforce Innovation Area (LWIA) Managers/Coordinators.

Embed Illinois workNet Service Finder on Your Website

There are two ways to access the customizable Illinois workNet Service Finder widget.

- Click the “Embed on Your Website” button on the [Illinois workNet Service Finder page](#).



- Access Embeddable Widgets from the [Illinois workNet footer](#).



Option 1: After clicking the “Embed on Your Website” button on the Service Finder page, fill in the fields to generate a code snippet to use on your website. See below for more details.

- There are several options to choose from, depending if you would like to specify the Search Type, How to Search, City or Zip Code and distance.
- Once you select the desired options, copy the code to place on your website.
- Scroll below the sample view to find the Variable Height Widget section.

Option 2: Once on the Embeddable Widgets page, select “Illinois workNet Service Finder”.

1. Read through the Styling Tips, Fixed Size Widgets, Borders, Variable Height Widgets, and Content Management Systems to familiarize yourself with different ways to customize the embedded widget.
2. When you are ready to generate your own code, click on [Service Finder Code Generator](#) located under the “Configure your own” section.
4. Provide the needed criteria to generate a code to be embedded on your website. Customize the widget by selecting the Search Type, How to Search, City or Zip Code and distance.
5. Once you select the desired options, copy the code to place on your website.

Styling Tips

This widget is embedded on your page as an iframe. Iframes typically default to 300 pixels wide by 200 pixels high. This is quite small. The content shown by the widget is not of a fixed height. The following tips will help you work through these problems. Don't worry, it's not difficult, it's really easy.

Variable Height Widget

If you include some additional code on your page, you can have your page resize the widget so that no scroll bars show. The techniques used for this are known to work in Internet Explorer 9 and newer, Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari (on Windows, Mac, and iOS devices), and the default browser that ships with Android.

1. If you're not using jQuery on your page, you **must** add this line to the <head> </head> section of your page:

```
<script type="text/javascript" src="https://apps.ill-work-net.com/locator/Scripts/jquery-1.10.0.min.js"></script>
```

Our code is known to work with jQuery 1.8.3 and newer. It may work in older versions, but this has not been tested.
2. Add the following two lines to the <head> </head> section of your page:

<script type="text/javascript" src="https://www.illinoisworknet.com/_layouts/15/1033/scripts/workNet/frameResize.js"></script>
