#### The Office of Illinois Works



**Illinois Works** was created as a result of Governor Pritzker's historic \$45 billion capital plan and his commitment to expanding equity in the Illinois' construction workforce.

- ➤ Data shows that the construction industry and the trades have not been accessible for diverse communities.
- ➤ Fewer than 10% of apprenticeships are extended to women and minorities.
- ➤ The Illinois Works Jobs Program Act was intentionally designed to increase equity and opportunity in capital construction jobs.





# **Illinois General Assembly**



The Illinois General Assembly is the bicameral legislature of the U.S. state of Illinois and is comprised of the Illinois House of Representatives and the Illinois Senate.

The Illinois General Assembly passed the (30 ILCS 559/) Illinois Works Jobs Program Act on June 28th, 2019. Through the Illinois Works Jobs Program Act the Illinois General Assembly appropriated funds for the pre-apprenticeship program.





# Illinois Works Jobs Program



The **Illinois Works Jobs Program Act** is a statewide initiative to ensure that all Illinois residents have access to state capital projects and careers including, in the construction industry and building trades.

The goal is to provide contracting and employment opportunities to historically underrepresented populations in the construction industry.



The construction industry and the trades have not been accessible for diverse communities with fewer than ten percent of apprenticeships extended to women and minorities.







# Illinois Works Jobs Program





The intent of these key programs is to expand apprenticeship opportunities, with a targeted focus on underrepresented populations.

An expansion of apprenticeship opportunities will help boost employment and wages for more Illinois residents. It will also yield significant benefits for our economy at large since the construction sector is projected to grow 12% in the next ten years.





# **Illinois Works Jobs Program**



- ➤ On average, jobs in this sector pay \$18 per hour to apprentices enrolled in DOL registered apprenticeship programs, and \$32 per hour to those that successfully achieve journey worker status.
- ➤ Investments in job training in the construction industry result in significant long-term economic impact totaling \$1.2 billion.
- ➤ For every dollar invested in construction job training, Illinois obtains \$11 in social and economic returns.

# Illinois Works Apprenticeship Initiative




The Illinois Works Apprenticeship Initiative opens doors of opportunity into the construction industry and the trades. It applies to public works projects with an estimated cost of \$500,000 or more, including both capital grants and direct capital contracts and awards.

The goal is for U.S. Department of Labor certified apprentices to perform:

- > 10% of total labor hours actually worked in each prevailing wage category or
- ➤ 10% of the estimated labor hours in each prevailing wage category, whichever is less.

# **Agency Responsibilities**

Upon completion of the grant/contract, collect certification and submit it to DCEO Illinois Works Office.



# Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program



The **Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program** creates a qualified talent pipeline to fill job opportunities with diverse candidates. This program delivers pre-apprenticeship skills training through a network of community-based organizations.

Participants will attend tuition-free and receive a stipend and other supportive services to help address systemic barriers preventing them from entering the construction industry.





# Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program





- > Pre-apprenticeship skills training through a network of community-based organizations.
- Preference to underrepresented populations that have historically encountered barriers to entry or advancement in the trades.
- > Free Tuition and a stipend to participants who attend the program.
- \$25M appropriated Illinois Works Funds for the grant program.



# Illinois Works Bid Credit Program



The **Illinois Works Bid Credit Program** incentivizes contractors to hire and retain a diverse pool of candidates. It allows contractors and subcontractors to earn bid credits by employing apprentices who have completed the Illinois Works Pre-apprenticeship Program. Bid credits can be used toward future bids for public works projects contracted by the State of Illinois or an agency of the state.





# Illinois Works Bid Credit Program





- ➤ The Illinois Works Bid Credit Program allows contractors and subcontractors to earn bid credits for use toward future bids.
- ➤ Bid credits can only be earned for employing apprentices who have completed the Illinois Works Pre-apprenticeship Program on public works projects contracted by state agencies.
- ➤ **DCEO will determine the bid credit** earning rate by rule. The rate will be published and may include maximum bid credits allowed per contractor, per subcontractor, per apprentice, per bid, or per year.
- ➤ The Illinois Works Bid Credit Bank will be established and administered by DCEO. DCEO is developing a mechanism for tracking the bid credits.



### GOV. PRITZKER LAUNCHES ILLINOIS WORKS TRAINING PROGRAM, WITH \$10 MILLION TO EXPAND PRE-APPRENTICESHIPS STATEWIDE

Competitive NOFO seeks to expand pre-apprenticeship training programs and to boost diversity in construction trades in Illinois

SPRINGFIELD - Governor JB Pritzker and the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) today announced the launch of the new Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program, leveraging a \$10 million commitment from the State to provide additional training programs that will expand the talent pipeline while boosting diversity within the construction industry and building trades. A Notice of Found Opportunity (NCEO) released by the DCEO Illinois Works Office aims to expand access to training programs that will prepare residents for well-paying jobs in the trades – with plans to focus on reducing barriers to entry and increasing representation of women and people of color in these fields.

The Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program is a key component of the Illinois Works Jobs Program Act – a result of landmark legislation put forward by Governor Pritzker to prepare residents for jobs created by the historic \$45 billion capital expansion plan. DCEO is now accepting applications for grant proposals—to view the NOFO, please visit DCEO's website.

"The Illinois Works program is designed to turn the tide on representation in Illinois' construction trades, which for too long left women and people of color out of key jobs in the industry," said Governor JB Pritzker. "It's a down payment on our future and will help increase opportunities for thousands more residents – regardless of where they live – to join us as we revitalize our infrastructure and Rebuild a new Illinois."

Through the Pre-Apprenticeship Program, DCEO and the Office of Illinois Works aim to create a network of providers across the state to recruit, prescreen, and provide pre-apprenticeship skills training. More importantly, providers will structure pathways and manage the program graduates' transition from the pre-apprenticeship program to a full apprenticeship program in construction and building trades. DCEO estimates that pre-apprenticeship training programs supported by these grant funds will serve as many as 1.000 participants during the first program wear.

"Our new pre-apprenticeship training program is designed to help more Illinois residents, especially those from underrepresented populations, benefit from jobs created by our historic Rebuild Illinois capital plan – building a strong talent pipeline and career paths for those who need them most," said Sylvia Garcia, Acting





- c. strategies for overcoming barriers to entry and completion of an apprentice
- d. any prerequisites for acceptance into apprenticeship program.

Specific project outcomes, goals, and deliverables must be included in the proposal.

#### **Funding Information**

This grant program is utilizing: state funding appropriated by the Illinois General Assembly under the Illinois Works Act. It is anticipated that the Department will award \$10,000,000 for grants under this NOFO and that each individual grant should range between \$200,000 to \$550,000 depending on the number of cohorts the program proposes to deliver for one year. The Department will consider grant requests for less or more of the above-mentioned range when adequate technical arguments and reasonable outcomes are presented. 

This Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) sets forth the requirements for funding pre-apprenticeship programs as specified by the Illinois Works Job Program Act ("Illinois Works Act"), 30 ILCS 559/20-1. It is in the public policy interest of the State of Illinois (the "State") to ensure that all Illinois residents have access to State capital projects and careers in the construction industry and building trades, including those who have been historically underrepresented in those trades. To ensure that those interests are met, the General Assembly created the Illinois Works Pre-apprenticeship Program, the Illinois Works Apprenticeship Initiative, and the Illinois did Credit Program.



The goal of the Illinois Works Pre-apprenticeship Program is to provide grants to community-based or organizations or coalitions throughout the State that will recruit, prescreen, and provide pre-apprenticeship skills training. Successful granteses will also be expected to provide pathways and manage the transition from the pre-apprenticeship program to a full apprenticeship program to a full apprenticeship program in construction and building trades. The overarching focus of these grants is to fund programs that help underrepresented populations successfully transition into full apprenticeship programs in construction and building trades. These program elements include outreach and recruitment to bring participants into programs but also include program elements specifically designed to increase the probability of success for historically underrepresented individuals.

"Community-based organization" means a nonprofit organization, including accredited public college or university. To qualify as a "community-based organization must demonstrate the following:

- the ability to effectively serve diverse and underrepresented populations, including by providing employment services to such populations;
- knowledge of the construction and building trades;
- the ability to recruit, prescreen, and provide pre-apprenticeship training to prepare workers for employment in the construction and building trades; and
- a plan to provide the following:
   a. preparatory classes:
- workplace readiness skills, such as resume preparation and interviewing techniques;
- c. strategies for overcoming barriers to entry and completion of an apprenticeship program: and
- d. any prerequisites for acceptance into apprenticeship program.

Specific project outcomes, goals, and deliverables must be included in the proposal.
