# WIOA Title I Policy Update

- Aligns with the Act/Regulations and DOL Guidance, TEGs, and PIRL reporting, etc. as well as common service definitions among partners (i.e. Career Pathways Dictionary)
  - PIRL Reporting Online Resource Release 2.0 (January 2020)
  - TEG 12-19 - National Dislocated Worker Grant Program Guidance
  - TEG 14-18 - Aligning Performance Accountability Reporting, Definitions, and Policies Across Workforce Employment and Training Programs Administered by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL)
  - TEG 19-16 - Guidance on Services provided through the Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
  - TEG 21-16 - Third Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I Youth Formula Program Guidance
  - TEG 13-16 - Guidance on Registered Apprenticeship Provisions and Opportunities in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
  - TEG 10-16, Change 1 - Performance Accountability Guidance for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I, Title II, Title III, and Title IV Core Programs
  - Career Pathways Dictionary – Contains an extensive base of stakeholders, developed agreed-upon definitions to ensure alignment across agencies, legal frameworks, and initiatives.



# WIOA Title I Services Policy

- ePolicy 4.2.3 Case Management/Career Planning –
  - Updated the WIOA Implementation guidance text of the policy.
  - Revised the Services Chart that was attached to the Exit Policy.
    - The definitions provided in this document are based on a combination of established State and federal statutes and regulations, TEGs, as well as reporting requirements such as the PIRL.
    - As appropriate, these definitions have been further refined through interagency and stakeholder engagement, and are strategically aligned to the fullest extent possible in order to minimize duplication and confusion.
      - ABE, ASE, Foreign Language HSE (Spanish) Instruction, and English as a Second Language (ESL)/English Language Acquisition (ELA) definitions confirmed with Adult Education.
      - Updates to Registered Apprenticeships based on TEGs and PIRL reporting elements.
      - Reconciling the Work-Based Learning activity of Work Experience is an individualized career service for reporting purposes; however the IWIB has allowed it to be counted as “training” towards the minimum training expenditure requirement.
  - Future updates include convening a working group regarding career planning which would include assessment guidance and adding resources developed for other grant opportunities.

# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Conclusion:

- Streamlined Dropdowns in IWDS -
  - Identified Work Based Learning Services (WBLs).
  - Identified Supportive Services with “SS” pre-fix.
  - Services in the Career vs. Training Levels match PIRL Categories.
  - One New Service Level for Youth.
  - Programmers Implemented Requested Changes in IWDS.
  - Staff Tested in IWDS Test Environment (ongoing).



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Training Service Level: IA and ID

Examples of Services *new* to Dropdown –

- “Adult Secondary Education (ASE)” - this replaced “GED/Equivalency”
- “Other Non Occupational Skills Training” (435) – this replaced “Other Academic Training”
- “Non Registered Apprenticeship” (838)



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Training Service Level: IA and ID

### *Services Removed From Training Level -*

- Remedial Training (433) – “Remedial” – this term is not in line with Adult Ed definition = Development Education
- English Language Proficiency (434) - (Career)
- Financial Literacy Education (496) - (Career)
- Personal Counseling (497) - (Career)
- Pre-Apprenticeship Training (421) - (Career/WBL)
- Transitional Jobs (812) - (Career/WBL)
- Adult Education and Literacy Activities (813) - Career (ABE)
- Job Readiness Combined with Other Forms of Training (Career) = Short-term Prevocational Svcs.
- Vocational Retraining (825) – Replaced with Skill Upgrading and Retraining (825)



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Career Service Level: IA, ID

Examples of the “new” labels are...

- “Adult Basic Education (ABE) Developmental Education” (813) - Replaced Adult Education and Literacy, Remedial Training, Basic Education.
- “Career Planning (Case Management)” (411) – Renamed per WIOA
- “Comprehensive and Specialized Assessments (Tests)” (817) - Replaced Asset Development, Diagnostic Testing, In-Depth Interviewing and Assessments, Tests.
- “Group Workforce Research/Workshops/Job Clubs” (819) – Replaced Workshops, Job Club, Individual Job Development, Workforce Information.



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Career vs. Training: IA, ID

PIRL Service Reporting - Career or Training?

### CAREER Services (ONLY):

Performance Measures: Employment 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Rates (MEDIAN 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter after Exit)

- “Adult Basic Education (ABE) (Developmental Education)” (813)
- “English Language Education” (434)
- “Job Readiness Courses w/Training” (815)



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Career vs. Training: IA, ID

PIRL Service Reporting - Career or Training?

### TRAINING Services -

Performance Measures: Measurable Skill Gains and/or Credential Attainment Rate (in addition to Employment measures).

- Adult Secondary Education (ASE) (431)
- Entrepreneurial Skills Training (IA, ID) – MSG ONLY? Customized Training Contracts?
- Definitions to be updated...



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## IWDS Screen Modifications:

### Service Screens for...

- Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP):
  - When service is being recorded, on screen, much choose YES or NO to: OJT (Private/Public) and/or Skill Upgrading and Retraining.
  - Per PIRL, 1305 - when OJTs or Skill Upgrading is provided as a part of an apprenticeship program, DO NOT record them as separate services.
- Training Paid by NON-WIOA Title I Funds:
  - Dropdown – \* Non Title I Funding Source for Training: Apprenticeship Expansion; Other (Specify); Private Sector Training; Public Sector Training, WIOA Title II; WIOA Title III; WIOA Title IV.
  - This service is available on BOTH Career and Training level dropdowns and is available for YOUTH.

## **NEW in IWDS: One Youth Service Level – Dropdown Lists Will Include All Available Youth Services:**

### **“Youth Service Elements: Education/Training/Career”**

- Removed Youth Service Levels - “Work Related Services”, “Academic Learning Services”, “Case Management” and “Summer Program”
- 14 Required Youth Elements
- DEFINE: TEGL 21-16, pages 14-23
- TEGL 10-16, Change 1 Attachment 7 - Table B WIOA Title I Youth Program



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Single Dropdown for Youth Services:

### “Youth Service Elements: Education/Training/Career”

- NEW Services Created and Added to Youth:
  - WBL – OJT – Private Sector (Youth) (840)
  - WBL – OJT – Public Sector (Youth) (839)
  - WBL – Internship- Youth Summer Months (841)
  - Youth Entrepreneurial Skills Training (843)
  - Non Registered Apprenticeship (838)

**NOTE! Youth OJTs and Youth Entrepreneurial Skills Training are NOT Training. This is different for IA and ID.**



# WIOA Title I Service Updates

## Single Dropdown for Youth Services:

**“Youth Service Elements: Education/Training/Career”**

## Youth Career Services Do Not Trigger Participation in MSG or Credential Attainment Rate Performance Measures:

- Tutoring/Study Skills Instruction/Dropout Prevention (439)
- Alternative School/Dropout Recovery Services (806)
  - Includes Adult Basic Education and English Language Education

**NOTE! Youth OJTs and Youth Entrepreneurial Skills Training are NOT Training. This is different for IA and ID.**

- These services are available to DWG Participants ONLY.
