





Benefits of Immersive Learning

- Hands-On approach; learning through practice and experience
- Student learning regardless of prior preparation
- Stimulates curiosity and motivation
- Mastery of the content and skills
- Helps to accelerate learning
- Assists students understanding of abstract and complex concepts
- Enhances and enriches the teaching experience (yes, Faculty can benefit too)
- Learning in a distraction free environment
- Develop collaborative and team-building skills
- The research themes land on the emotional and intellectual connections

Anatomy



- Can bring clarity to the complexity of anatomy

- Ability to interact with the content helps with connection and retention
- Promotes stronger recall

Engineering



- From inception to manufacturing
 - Conceptualization
 - Interact with Design
 - Testing
 - Assembly
 - Manufacturing
- Increases motivation, interest and engagement
- Comprehension and Retention



Industrial Maintenance


- Make mistakes without destroying equipment
- More fully trained prior to apprenticeship or internship
- Less downtime for training
- Students can immerse themselves in their future occupations
- Training can be done "on demand" for high-risk task before heading to the site





Manufacturing and Welding

- Skills development
- Reductions in material waste
- Can be projected on the safety glass removing the need for head gear
- Reduction of equipment downtime or failure
- Enables the student to better understand and simplify machine operation

Physical Fitness Education

- Increased interest in fitness
- Increased physical activity





Adult Education / Workforce Development

- Accelerates the acquisition of key foundational skills
- Greater recall of the content
- Improves communications and life management skills
- Timely, relevant, real-time, hands-on knowledge and experiences aligned to real work or life activities





Language Training

- Real life scenarios
- Flexible and authentic
- Interactive
- Builds greater confidence
- Cultural context and awareness
- Better recall and knowledge retention





Criminal Justice and First Responders



- Helps to hone critical skills
- Builds confidence
- Better situational awareness
- Builds stronger interpersonal skills with public

- Studies addressed that recall of content, skills, mastery and their potential occupations can be improved through:
 - Emotional
 - Intellectual
 - Behavioral
 - Self-efficacy
 - Confidence
 - ... and a sense of belonging and teamwork
- Immersive Learning embraces and fosters those connections
- The greater the connection mentally and emotionally the greater the retention and completion of students.



The silos will continue to fall

- The Crystal Ball
 - The short-term vs. the future
 - Education will not tie itself to monikers and silos of in-person/face-to-face, online, hybrid, etc.
 - We will only have learning. Learning through lecture, labs, texts, sensory, psychomotor, emotional, cognitive... we will experience learning fully.
 - Personalization and Adaptive Instruction: One size no longer fits
- A day made of glass 2 (3:12+)... a glimpse of what could be.



- Immersive learning and what replaces it will continue to:
 - Enhance teaching and learning
 - Assist students to be more active learners
 - Create more personalized education opportunities
 - Contribute to greater collaboration and team-building skills
 - Improve a students readiness for their occupation
 - Build their confidence and self-efficacy
 - ... and more



The use of immersive learning and associated technologies for higher education is still emerging, and remains the most under implemented and under-researched areas. Yet, offers considerable possibilities for instructors and students.
