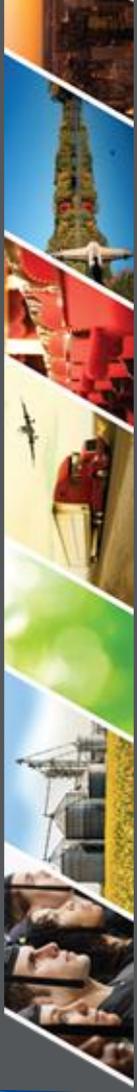
How Changes Are Released

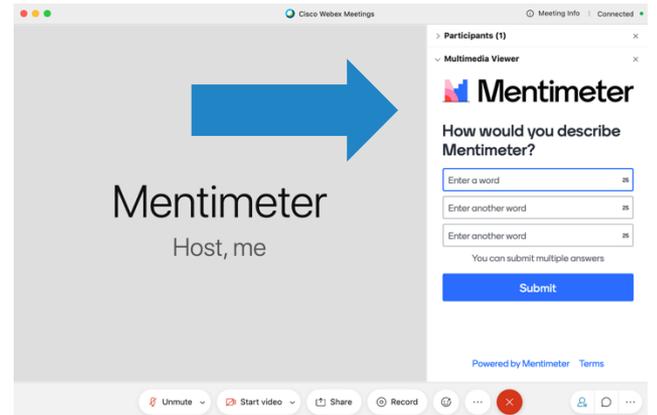
