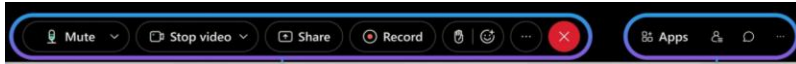

## How does the Bid Credit Program Work (basic steps)?

- Contractor **Registers** online for the free Bid Credit Program
- Contractor **Hires and Retains** ILWPP Graduates
- Contractor **Earns** Bid Credits (virtual dollars) by hiring and retaining *Qualified Apprentices* who work on construction projects, private or public, in the State of Illinois
- Contractor **Redeems** earned bid credits on State capital-funded projects, which lowers their bids making them more competitive

## Bid Credits = Virtual Dollars

If a contractor or subcontractor earns a **Bid Credit**, it means that the **virtual dollar** earned can be used to bid on state funded capital construction projects.

**Virtual dollars** remain as such and **are never** converted into **real dollars!**



# Bid Credits

1. Bid credits can be earned by **ANY** contractor working in the State of Illinois that employs an ILWPP graduate who **IS** enrolled **OR** sponsored into a US DOL-RAP.
2. Bid credits can be earned on **ANY** project, public or private.
3. Bid credits are earned based on the **mean statewide prevailing wage rate** for the graduate's construction trade.
4. Bid credits are earned at the rate of **\$0.50 for every hour** a qualified apprentice works.



# Qualified Apprentice



## A **Qualified Apprentice**:

- has **completed** the Illinois Works Pre-apprenticeship Program;
- is actively **enrolled** in a USDOL-registered apprenticeship program in the construction trades
- is **six years or less** from the date first enrolled in a USDOL-registered apprenticeship program.

# What Are the Benefits of the Bid Credit Program for Contractor/ Employers?

- Compliance with the 10% Apprenticeship Initiative goal (5% ILWPP Graduates, Climate Works, HCCTP) on State-funded construction projects \$500,000+
- Competitive bidding edge Lowering their bids making them more competitive on State capital-funded projects, when applying their Bid Credits or pooling with other contractors
- Unlimited Earning Potential (Bid Credits/virtual dollars) on the number of *Qualified Apprentices*

# Bid Credit Regions

**North Region** includes the following counties: McHenry, Lake, DeKalb, Kane, DuPage, Cook, Kendall, Will, Grundy and Kankakee.

**South Region** includes the remainder of the state.

Bid Credits earned **MUST** be redeemed in the same region.

Bid Credits earned in the North Region can only be redeemed in North Region.

Bid Credits earned in the South Region can only be redeemed in South Region.




# Bid Credit Program – Earning Bid Credits

Mean Statewide Prevailing Wage x Total Hours Worked on CP x BC Earning Rate

Below is an example of a **Carpenter** with **40 hours** reported on their Certified Payroll:

$\$42.21 \times 40 \times \$0.50 = \$844.20$  Bid Credits Earned

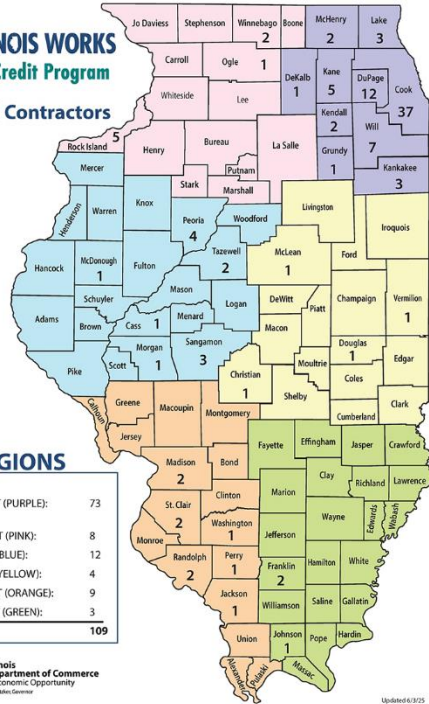

# Illinois Works Bid Credit Program

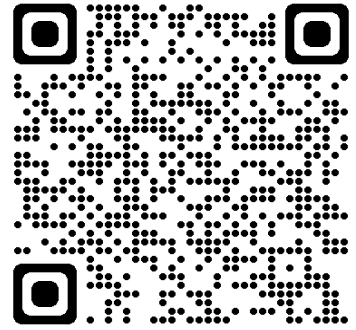


The Bid Credit Program provides bid credits or virtual dollars to contractors or subcontractors who employ Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program graduates as qualified apprentices. Contractors or subcontractors are eligible to earn bid credits on every hour worked by the qualified apprentice in their Department of Labor Registered Apprenticeship Program (DOL-RAP) on any project, public or private. These earned bid credits can be used by the contractor or subcontractor to win state-funded capital construction projects by making their bids more competitive.

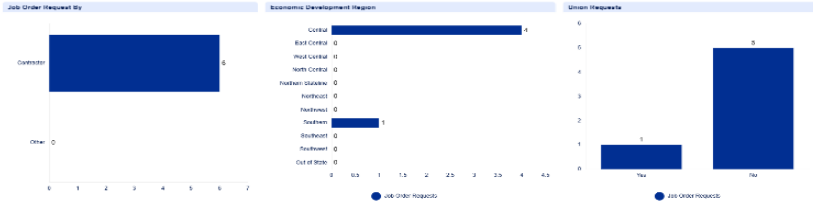

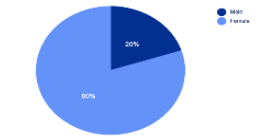

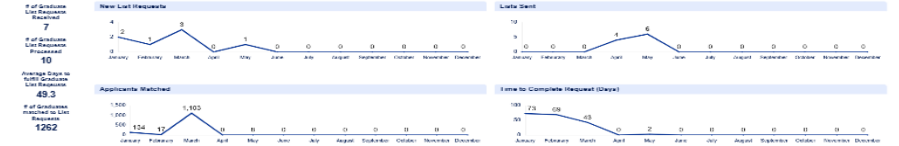

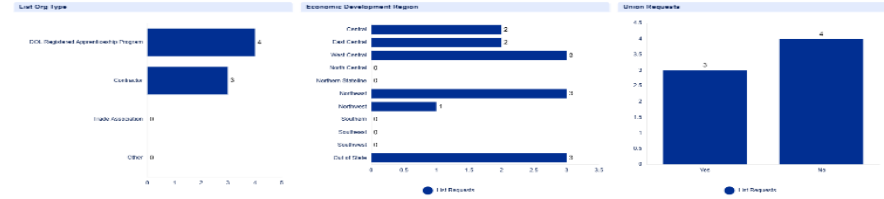

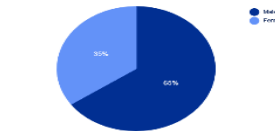

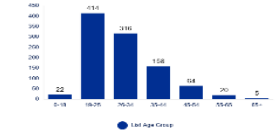
### List Match Graduate's Gender



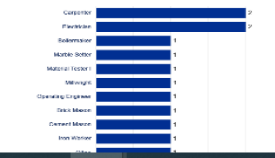

# What is the Post Program Career Plan (PPCP)?

- The Post Program Career Plan (PPCP) is the roadmap to our graduates' transition to becoming a Journeyman.
- PPCP is the result of the ILWCS Team contacting Graduates to complete the Post Program Active Tracking Follow-up Questionnaire.
- The PPCP is created by the ILW Career Services Specialists in IWRS.



# Where do I locate the Post Program Career Plan (PPCP)?
