Required Information

As the BCP anticipates the approval of the administrative rules, please check out the tips below regarding the information required for the BCP forms you will need to complete:



Contractor Registration

- FULL company name, FEIN, corporate address, and contact information including email
- Construction trades, company size, years in business and certifications
- ALL BCP contractors MUST have staff hired and working within the borders of the State of Illinois. If you do NOT your registration will be DECLINED

Bid Credit Apprentice Report (Requesting Bid Credits)

- Employee/Apprentice name, Last 4 of SSN, and Illinois Works Graduate ID (IWRS)
 - If your employee/apprentice does NOT know their IWRS number, they will need to contact their ILWPP grantee.
- Apprenticeship program type, name, and current apprentice year for employee/apprentice
- Certified payroll report for verification of total payroll hours, total gross wages, payroll date, and payroll start and end dates
