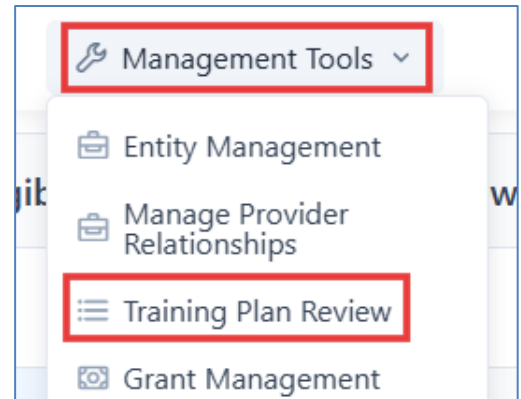
Audience

- Select **Management Tools > Training Plan Review**.
- The Eligible Training Program Review Page is displayed.
- The Eligible Training Program Review page features a program search and list view of providers with programs needing review and their statuses.

Change the Training Program Status

- After clicking reviewing the training program changes, select the **Change Status** button.
- A pop-up will prompt the user to set the program status and **Save**.
- If the reviewer selects "DCEO Coordinator does not approve and disagrees with the LWIB Recommendation" additional required reasons will display.
- After approving, the status changes to approved and the start date will be set to the day after the expiration of current program and end date 2 years after the start date.
