

# Job Training and Economic Development Moderate-Income Eligibility

The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) office of Employment and Training (OET) will utilize the Secretary of the Treasury (Treasury) rules for the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) that<sup>1</sup> established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) definition of moderate income as (i) income at or below 300 percent of the FPG for the size of its household based on the most recently published poverty guidelines by HHS.
