Update on New Cohort

- We have received approval from FNS that the new Cohort. Illinois workNet is going to begin working on updating the front-end invitation process. Additional information regarding changes to the system will be provided as things are updated.
- We also received verbal approval for the budget modifications that were submitted, we are still waiting on final approval.
- We will be looking at modification to grant agreements to modify budget line items in April.

New Cohort Customer Outreach

- Tammy would like for CBOs to come up with a strategy on how to outreach to SNAP Recipients.
- Waiting List - Since the new invitation system will not be operating until May, CBOs are encouraged to create a waiting list for interested customers. CBO's should determine if a customer is a good fit for their training program up front so there could potential be a cohort of customers ready for eligibility determination rather than one at a time.
- **Reminder – customers cannot already have been randomized, must be SNAP eligible and cannot be receiving TANF.**
