Purpose of Webinar

- ▶ To ensure LWIAs and DCEO are aware of and using the new Layoff Recovery Tools.



Tools

- ▶ **Business Layoffs & Closings**
 - See all layoffs (pulled in from DETS) in your LWIA or all LWIAs for DCEO.
 - “Create” button for company specific layoff pages.
- ▶ **Partner Dashboard**
 - Manage company layoff pages – Activate, Expire, and Re-Activate.
 - Add customized questions to survey, add local documents, and survey batch entry.
- ▶ **Reporting Dashboard**
 - Review surveys entered in by laid off workers, and export data.
 - See info for laid off workers that want contacted – mark as “finished” once contact has been made.
- ▶ **Company Specific Layoff Pages**
 - Tools for LWIAs to ensure layoff response is easy and timely. Partners should add local printables, messages, services, events, and opportunities, and collect surveys from impacted workers.

Company's Specific Layoff Pages



- ▶ **Purpose:** To help and guide workers through transition to re-employment.
- ▶ **Use for Workers:** Making sure workers who attend a layoff workshop have access to information covered to view and download when/where they want.
- ▶ **Accessibility:** Available to workers anywhere they have internet access; including mobile devices.
- ▶ **Surveys:** Collect responses once pages are created; enter batch entry only if page is created.

Illinois Department Of Employment Security To Be At Lyon, LLC, Plant 07/28/2014

A representative of the Illinois Department of Employment Security (IDES) will be present at the Lyon, LLC, plant in Paris, IL, on Monday, August 25, 2014, beginning at 12 noon. The purpose of the IDES representative's presence is to provide technical assistance to those persons affected by the Lyon plant closure in signing-up for Unemployment Insurance (U.I.) and to answer questions pertaining to the plant closure and U.I. benefits. The Lyon plant employees are asked to bring with them information pertaining to their bank checking account (bank routing number and checking account number—found at the bottom of each check) and on their dependent children (birth date and Social Security number).
