## Apprenticeship Employer Information

Did you know that there is a tax credit for businesses with apprentices? Effective January 1, 2020, employers are allowed a tax credit for qualified educational expenses associated with qualifying apprentices. Employers may receive a credit of up to \$3,500 per apprentice against the taxes imposed by subsections (a) and (b) of Section 201 of the Illinois Income Tax Act, and an additional credit of up to \$1,500 for each apprentice if (1) the apprentice resides in an underserved area or (2) the employer's principal place of business is located in an underserved area.

## Apprenticeship Employer Spotlight



Shawnee Health provides a comprehensive, coordinated health and social service center network to southern Illinois and southwest Indiana residents. With locations in Marion, Carterville, Carbondale, and Murphysboro, IL, Shawnee Health's network has become an essential partner in the Apprenticeship IL program. Their variety of apprenticeship programs for the positions of Medical Assistants and Dental Assistants provide participants with hands-on training while completing their coursework. Their first Registered Apprenticeship Program, developed for Medical Assistants, accepted its initial cohort in April 2021. The program's success led Shawnee Health to create an apprenticeship program for Dental Assistants. Additional cohorts for 2022 are full, and Shawnee Health will accept five Medical Assistant Apprentices and three Dental Assistant Apprentices throughout 2023.

According to Alex Hansen, Shawnee Health's Marketing Manager, "[Having a Registered Apprenticeship Program] has been an incredibly rewarding experience to provide opportunities to our community and help people achieve their career goals. There are few opportunities out there for individuals to receive an education and still receive a paycheck to feed their families. We are honored to be able to provide this for the region and usher in the next generation of medical professionals."


