Dear Chairman Newberg:

I am pleased to advise you of my conditional approval of your request for DeWitt County to remain aligned with Local Workforce Innovation Area 19 (LWIA 19) including Macon County.

The realignment of DeWitt County was considered in response to a monitoring finding by the United States Department of Labor regarding Section 106(a)(2) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act ("WIOA") and 20 C.F.R. § 679.210, which require local workforce areas to be located within a single economic development region.

The approval of DeWitt County's request to remain configured with LWIA 19 is approved pursuant to the authority provided by the United States Department of Labor's conditional approval of Illinois' waiver request of WIOA Section 106(a)(2)and 20 C.F.R. § 679.210. This approval is contingent on the following:

- DeWitt County's participation in the regional planning process of both the Central and North Central regions; and
- DeWitt County's acknowledgement that DeWitt County and LWIA 19 will complete a realignment process in 2020 if the waiver described above is not renewed by the United States Department of Labor.
