NATIONAL DISLOCATED WORKER GRANTS

 The COVID NDWGs are high profile grants that will be monitored by the US Department of Labor.

- Open NDWG grants in Illinois
 - Opioid Disaster Recovery: LWIAs 1, 4, 7, 10, 14, 19
 - COVID Disaster: LWIAs 1, 6, 7, 13, 14, 15, 24, 25
 - COVID Employment Recovery: LWIAs 1, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 22/24



ALLOWABLE SERVICES

- Career Services: Basic (e.g. career counseling, workforce and labor market information, referrals to partners) and Individualized (e.g. specialized assessments, career planning, work experiences/Transitional Jobs)
- Training Services: Work-based Training (On-the-Job training, Registered Apprenticeship, Customized) and Occupational Skills Training (training from Eligible Training Providers)
- Supportive Services: and needs-related payments enable individuals to participate in disaster-relief and employment and training services
- Disaster Recovery Services: Disaster Relief Employment, DR Safety Training, DRE Supportive Services



DISASTER RELIEF EMPLOYMENT

Disaster Recovery Grants May Include:

Temporary employment on projects that provide food, clothing, shelter, and other humanitarian assistance for emergency and disaster victims, and on projects for demolition, cleaning, repair, renovation, and reconstruction of damaged and destroyed structures, facilities, private property under certain circumstances, and lands located within a disaster area.
